It was then that Roger Stott handed her the memoir he had begun writing about the period leading up to what he referred to as the traumatic " Nazi decade, " the years in the 1960s in which he and other Brethren leaders enforced coercive codes of behavior that led to the breaking apart of families, the shunning of members, even suicides. Now he was trying to examine that time, and his complicity in it, and he asked Rebecca to write about it, to expose all that was kept hidden.
