Guided Reading Resources – Mrs Mactivity

Guided reading is a group method of teaching reading skills that can be used in place of, though usually in addition to, occasional 1:1 reading and discrete phonics instruction. Generally speaking, guided

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reading involves teaching groups of children according to their ability levels.

3. Phonics/Word Study. If you wish to include word study in your guided reading lessons, you will need to have some digital flashcards with words for students to sound and blend, and for sight word practice. I use the phonics flashcards to practice sounding and blending words with students.

Distance Learning: Remote Guided Reading Lessons Made Easy ...

Guided reading is all about practice, so have students whisper read (or silently read – in late first grade and second grade) all of the words on their own. That said, some students in Kindergarten or early first grade may need more support than the book introduction in order to be successful with the text.

What are the components of a guided reading lesson in a ...

Before the students begin reading, introduce the text. You might introduce new concepts or vocabulary words, give a brief synopsis of the book, call attention to a new phonics pattern, have your learners do a picture walk or make predictions, and/or set a purpose for reading.

Warm-up/fluency items (letter sounds or sight words, rereading familiar texts or parts of a text for fluency. Text introduction (discussing content, pre-teaching vocabulary, teaching a reading strategy) Reading the text (students read independently while you listen in to one student at a time) Post-reading

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conversation (addressing comprehension, re-visiting the teaching point or strategy from the text introduction, discussing how students could apply this learning to their independent reading)

Start by introducing the sight word by building the word on the cookie sheet. You might say something like this, "This word is can.". Point to each letter and say the letter name, "c - a - n, can.". You can then practice mixing it up and fixing it or removing a letter and having students find which one is missing.

Focus. Really effective guided reading sessions have a sharp focus and stick to it. Try keeping to just one or two aspects of the Content Domain. Ask questions focussed on these aspects and try to limit your assessment notes to these aspects too (see our guided reading prompts at the bottom of this page).
