No matter where the loose seam is or what caused it, the repair procedure is the same: Dip a small artist's brush into wallpaper-seam adhesive (about \$3 for a 4-oz. tube at paint and wallcovering stores). Spread an even coat of adhesive onto the underside of the exposed seam (photo 1). Then use a wooden seam roller to flatten the seam (photo 2).

Wallpaper Repairs Made Easy - This Old House

Lightly dampen the loose edge or seam. This step softens the adhesive. Lift the loose edge. Raise the lifted edge with a knife. Place the pointed nozzle of the seam adhesive under the loose edge, seam, or tear and squeeze enough adhesive to coat the torn area. Don't apply so much that it get drippy.

Gently lift up the loose seam or rip to expose the wall sHow to Replace or Repair Damaged Wallpaperurface underneath. Use a small artist's paintbrush to spread a thin layer of adhesive on the paper itself and gently press it back into place, taking care not to trap any air bubbles.

If you need to replace entire lengths/strips of wallpaper, you should mix a new packet of wallpaper paste. Soft, lint-free cloth and rags, fine paintbrushes, a seam roller and a cutter knife are essential repair tools. Set everything up within reach and always make sure you have enough time on your hands and aren't under time pressure or stress.

Moisten the peeling or damaged portion of the seam. Then carefully lift up the loose section of wallpaper and, using a small brush, apply a thin, even coating of wallpaper glue or adhesive to the underside of the piece you wish to reattach. 2 Reseat the wallpaper seam. Press the piece of wallpaper back into place.

For loose edges, start by pulling the wallpaper away from the wall. Continue to pull until you reach the point at which the peeling ends and the rest is still securely attached. Next, take a small paintbrush and apply a thin layer of repair glue to the loose piece's back end.

To fix an air-filled wallpaper bubble, you'll need a utility knife, a syringe, glue, a damp sponge, and a roller. 1 Use the utility knife to slit the bubble. Be sure to keep the slit as small as possible so it won't be visible when the repair is done. 2 Push down on the bubble to remove the air from the bubble.

If you get a tear in the wallpaper it is easily repaired. Taking care not to tear the paper further, peel back the torn section. Using a fitch apply wallpaper paste or PVA to the section of exposed wall without getting it onto the surrounding paper. Smooth the torn flap of paper back in position with a damp sponge.

Select a piece of scrap wallpaper is exactly the same as the portion that you want to repair. Color match the edges and everything above and below. Don't look at the center only. Depending on the pattern and repeat, you may have a form that repeats frequently, but on several different colors.

Vacuum the damaged wallpaper seam to remove any dust or debris on the wall behind the seam. Use a soft brush attachment on the vacuum to avoid causing more damage to the wallpaper. Step 2 Apply a small amount of wallpaper seam sealer on the seam using an artist's paintbrush.
