USS Ward was a 1,247-long-ton Wickes-class destroyer in the United States Navy during World War I, later APD-16 in World War II. USS Shaw was a Mahan-class destroyer and the second ship of the United States Navy to be named for Captain John Shaw, a naval officer.
