Mrs Oliphant (or Margaret Oliphant Wilson Oliphant) was born in 1828 and died in 1897. She married her cousin, Frank Wilson Oliphant in 1852, and he died only a number of years later, leaving her with three surviving children. Writing was her lifeline and her income earner.

Mrs Oliphant. Margaret Oliphant. Margaret Oliphant, née Wilson (1828-97), was born in Scotland, where her father was a bank clerk; when she was 10 the family moved to Liverpool. She had no formal education, but read widely and was encouraged to write by her mother, publishing her first novel when she was 21. In 1852 she married her cousin Frank Oliphant, and lived at different times in Edinburgh, London and Italy.
