Research tends to indicate that a student's reading comprehension can be improved by focusing on teaching students skills in the following areas:

Provide extra practice in reading words, sentences, and stories. Use cognate words in the native language as synonyms when teaching vocabulary. Identify and clarify difficult words and passages. Consolidate knowledge of the text through the use of summaries. Find appropriate ways to use the native language.

Young learners of English need explicit instruction on the link between the symbols (letters) in English and the sounds they make. They need to be taught that there is a direct link between the phonemes (sounds) and graphemes (letters) in order to be able to start 'blending' or sounding out simple words, e.g. vowel consonant (VC), followed by consonant vowel consonant (VC).

Teaching Reading and Comprehension to English Learners ...

- Phonics is based on the systematic teaching of sound and letter relationships, as well as sound and spelling patterns. This is helpful in beginning English reading instruction. Children who have learned to read prior to formal schooling do not need such instruction. Older readers do not benefit as much from phonics instruction.
